**Getting there** Car-pooling or convoy will leave Beadesert Info. Centre at 9:30am **OR** Meet on site at 10am

**Directions** From the main traffic lights intersection in the centre of Beadesert CBD, proceed on the Kerry Road past Kerry (do NOT turn off) and continue on the same road past picturesque Darlington School towards Lost World. At 30 km from Beadesert you will cross a large new concrete bridge over the Albert River (**you are there!**) Turn left immediately after the bridge into Darlington Park (the park extended both sides of the road). Look for the BBB flag. Brochures on Darlington Park are available at major tourist venues and Information Centres in the Scenic Rim.
