

## THE ABPA RECOMMENDED METHOD OF ALLOCATING RESULTS FOR PERFORMANCE COMPETITIONS

### The Rank Order is

the position that a judge would have each contestant in relation to the other contestants using the scores that the judge has allocated for the respective performance. .

For example Judge A who has given Black a Raw Score of 95 is (1) in the Rank Order for this judge while White who was given 80 has a Rank Order of (10)

Where the raw scores are the same then they must be given the same Rank Order.

For example Judge B has given Dark, Blue and Red scores of 82 so they are given the same Rank Order of (7) but this takes out the Rank Order places of (8) and (9) so the next lowest score of 75 has the Rank Order of (10).

The recommended process is to add the Rank Orders of all three Judges and the lowest totals would be allocated the respective places as shown above.

### WHAT IF THE TOTALS OF THE RANK ORDERS ARE THE SAME?

#### TWO TIE-BREAKER PROCESSES CAN BE USED

First:

What the majority of judges awarded  
( the person that 2 out of 3 judges scored the highest)

	Judge A	Judge B	Judge C	TOTAL
Bill	84	80	81	245
Joe	81	81	84	246

BECAUSE JUDGES B & C HAVE JUDGED JOE HIGHER THAN BILL - JOE WINS

Second: The aggregate raw scores of the judges

FOR THE OVERALL FESTIVAL CHAMPION

- First: Use the rank order aggregates of the results of the categories.
- Second: Should there be a tie then use the raw scores aggregates of the categories'
- Third Should there still be a tie  
use the aggregate rank order for **both original sections.**
- Fourth Should there still be a tie  
use the aggregate **raw scores** of both original sections.
